What is Homeopathy?



Homeopathy is a form of holistic medicine. It is not new age, in fact many countries around the world have been using homeopathy for over 200 years, in some cases it is the first point of call for any health issues.

Homeopathic medicine treats the person as a whole, rather than treating specific conditions in isolation. For example if you are suffering from back pain, depression and sleep problems we would take all your ailments into account and may prescribe one remedy to cover all.

We consider all your needs whether they be mental, emotional or physical during a confidential in-depth consultation taking into account your lifestyle, diet, medical history, as well as your current health problems.

Is homeopathy safe?

Homeopathic treatment has an excellent safety record and because our medicines are non toxic they can be used in cases involving babies, children and is an excellent aid during pregnancy and child birth.

What will my homeopathic treatment involve?

Your initial consultation may take at least an hour, whilst follow up appointments are usually shorter. You will then be given or sent a remedy which takes into account everything that has been discussed. Homeopaths call their medicines remedies and may take tablet form or liquid. Full instructions will be given for you to follow.

How long does the treatment take?

There is no 'cut off point' and your treatment can continue until you and your homeopath agree you no longer need to attend. Appointments are usually once a month for a few months and then depending on how your health is progressing at longer intervals.

How does homeopathy perform in practice?

A recent survey at the Bristol Homeopathic Hospital recorded the outcome of treatment in over 6,500 consecutive patients during a six year period, and found that 70% of patients reported an improvement in their health. In Germany a similar survey 'showed that homeopathic treatment was more effective than conventional treatment for some chronic conditions commonly seen in general practice, including headache, low back pain, depression, insomnia, in adults and atopic dermatitis, allergic rhinitis and asthma in children.'

What scientific evidence is there that homeopathy works?

A health Technology Assessment report on homeopathy commissioned by the Swiss government 'has concluded that homeopathy is clinically effective, cost effective and safe.'
